Part of being a senior includes contributing something to the school to be used by future Rebels — the senior gift — known this year as the senior peace offering.

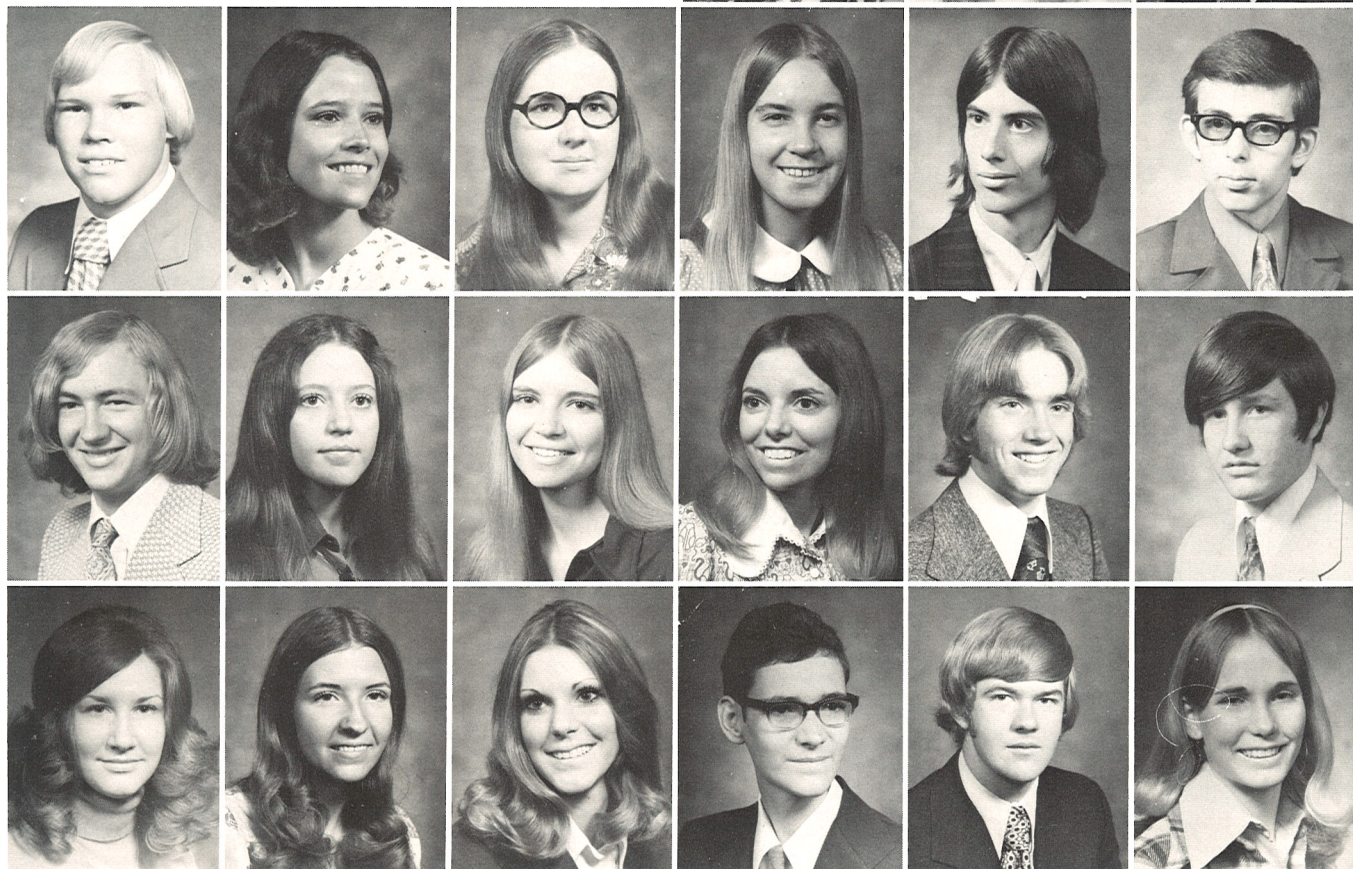
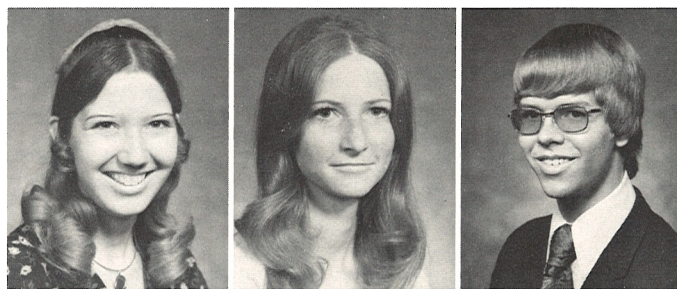
A special committee sponsored by Mrs. Lois Taylor, math teacher, took students' voluntary contributions and investigated student suggestions for the senior gift.
